Format "Challenge and Defence"

In preparation for the conference, each PhD student has to read the latest paper/research of another PhD student (see matching above). Everyone must also upload their (unfinished) paper so that everyone has all the papers. Each challenge and defence lasts 40 minutes.

10 minutes for the author to present

- 1) research question (how you found it, why is it important, what is the expected result)
- 2) methodology used (methodology = explanation of the whole research design, not just the method = tool)
- 3) main obstacles encountered during writing
- 4) intended journal and plan b journal chosen and why.

10 minutes for the challenger to critique (positively and negatively) the work as it is. The author may take notes but may not reply.

5 minutes exclusively for the author to answer and add information.

15 minutes of open debate - we do a kind of collective brainstorming and ask further questions, express ideas we have, formulate obstacles we see.

Format "Elevator Pitch"

Everyone should

- 1) introduce themselves in 60 seconds
- 2) present their doctoral thesis in 120 seconds

This will be followed by a short question and answer session (max. 2 questions) and thus 2 min.

Depending on the number of doctoral students who will be there, we can adjust the time a little.
